

ADMINISTRATION UPDATES

Recently the town board has enacted several new ordinances including those relating to stormwater and murals. Also, to adapt for growth and to be better prepared for the future, we are currently reviewing our land use plan and updating our zoning code.

Bidding for the Elizabeth Street drainage project and the Wastewater Treatment Plant are underway and we expect to award both projects sometime in April. The town continues to pursue grants for infrastructure, IT, and facilities.
